His technical skills and the range of his artistic palette extend across the stylistic boundaries of the Stride Piano, Swing, Bebop, Modal and Free Music movements. He has performed and recorded with artists including Nick Brignola, Dave Douglas, Dave Holland, Carter Jefferson, Franklin Kiermyer, Joe Lovano, J.R. Monterose, David "Fathead" Newman, Eric Person, Arthur Rhames,

Sam Rivers, Roswell Rudd, Pharaoh Sanders and John Stubblefield. He has created music for theater, dance, film, TV commercials, and multimedia performance art. STEVE WILSON (Alto Sax) has brought his distinctive sound to more than 100 recordings and ensembles led by celebrated artists including Chick Corea, Ron Carter, Christian McBride, George Duke, Michael Brecker, Dianne Reeves, Bill Bruford, Gerald Wilson, Maria Schneider, Joe Henderson, Charlie Byrd, Karrin Allyson, and Don Byron among many others. Wilson has seven recordings under his own name, leading and

collaborating with such stellar artists as Nicholas Payton, Mulgrew Miller, Rene Marie Ray Drummond, Cyrus Chestnut, Greg Hutchinson, and Ben Riley. A respected and passionate educator Wilson serves on the faculty at Manhattan School of Music, Juilliard, and SUNY Purchase Conservatory of Music, and has been artist in residence at institutions including University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, University of Manitoba, University of Maryland-College Park, The Peabody School, Eastman School of Music and Virginia Commonwealth University.
